





7 HOUSETYPES 1: PHASE 1-3 HOUSETYPES



The scheme comprises of ten different house types, with most properties arranged in short terraces facing onto the street. The majority of the townhouses come with parking on street at the front of the property, or within car ports to the rear.

Variations include houses on corner plots, some of these have second floor balconies, adding interest to the streetscape as you turn the corner. Many of the houses also have roof terraces, which overlook the road, making the street feel safe and welcoming.

Size

The floorpsace of the houses range from 92m² to 126m², and the height of the properties range from 2-3 storeys, with the exception of the apartment block which is 6 storeys high.

The housing mix for phases 1-3 is varied, the scheme contains 2, 3, 4 bedroom properties, but the majority of the properties have 3 bedrooms.

Materials


Most of the houses will have a brickwork facade, with different colours and types of brickwork being used to distinguish architectural elements.

Roof terraces will be made from wooden panels and these will look similar to those used on a previous scheme in the Meadows at Green Street, which was designed by the same architects:



Energy Efficiency


The houses will be designed to a high level of thermal integrity using a 'fabric first' approach. Windows and doors will be chosen to reflect this approach, so each property achieves a high standard of thermal insulation.























SECOND FLOOR - 260 m⁻






SECOND FLOOR = 257m² (Ex. Terrace)
