What If...

The Spode Works site will kick start the regeneration of Stoke Town; by opening up the site and breathing life and activity into the empty units we aim to energise the transformation of Stoke Town centre.





Spode Works and Stoke Town would benefit strongly from a much more direct connection to the station, university and the City Centre beyond. This could ideally take the form of a pedestrian/cycle bridge that would help to safely cross the canal and A500 Queensway. However in the short term this might be about improving the existing routes.

The Kings Hall is a spectacular venue and space - a hidden gem. We are aware it was and still is used for popular Northern Soul dance nights. The recent revival of this culture is influencing hotels in the area to change checking in/out policies to help revellers finishing early in the morning get a good 'days' sleep. Therefore we think the Kings Hall could be used even more to help promote a developing evening economy by supporting local bars, restaurants and hotels, to attract further people and activity into the area.
