New Housing Development

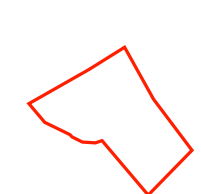
This exhibition provides information on our proposals for housing on the site of the former De La Salle College on Weaste Lane in Salford.

The campus merged with Salford City College in 2009 and following the proposal for a new campus in Media City, the site is to be sold for housing development.

This work will form part of an outline planning application for the site which is designed to agree the principle of housing design and establish guidelines for future development.



Proposed Housing



New housing on the site is intended to compliment the existing neighbourhood and improve access into and through the site especially for pedestrians. The development will provide up to 60 new homes, with a mix of two, three and four bedroom properties.

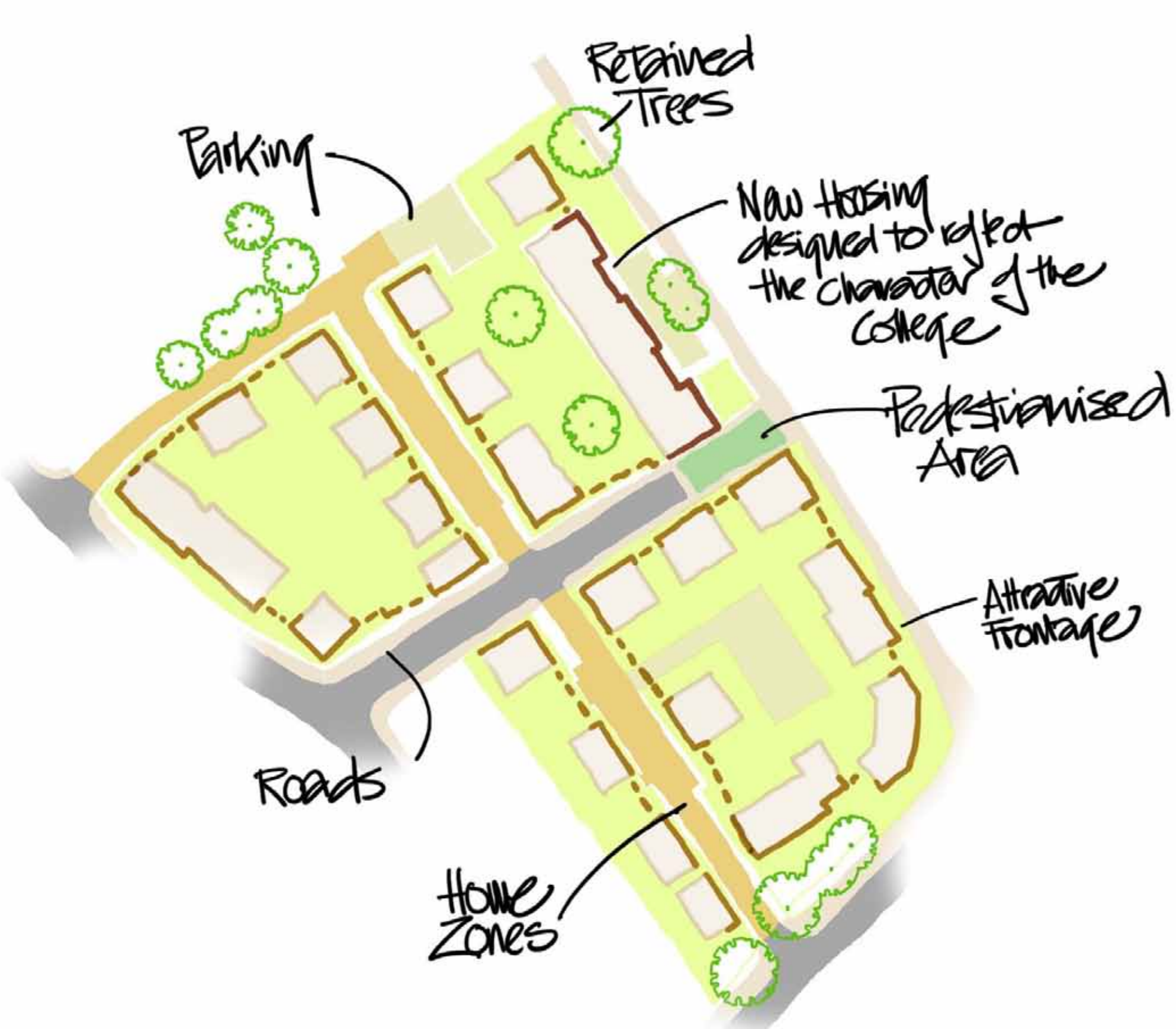


The site is located close to the Weaste Metrolink station which provides links into the city centre and out towards Eccles.



Housing Design

The houses will be mostly two-storeys high, with some three-storey properties. The houses haven't been designed in detail but will be subject to a reserved matters planning application by the developer.



Parking

All housing will have at least one parking space. Some properties will have two parking spaces and additional on street parking will be available for visitors.



Site History

The site currently consists of a number of school buildings and a small chapel. These were most recently used as Pendleton College 6th Form and the De La Salle Centre.
